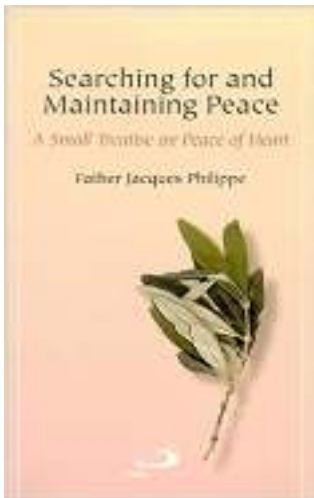

Fr. Casey was born on November 3rd, 1955, and is a native of Philadelphia, PA. He is a 1979 graduate of Temple University in Philadelphia. After graduating from college, Fr. Casey served as an officer in the U.S. Army, and gave up his military career in order to study for the priesthood. Upon completion of his military service, Fr. Casey entered the Congregation of the Fathers of Mercy, and has been a member of the community since 1986. He is a graduate of Holy Apostles Seminary in Cromwell, Connecticut.

Fr. Casey attributes his call to the priesthood to the Divine Mercy, his love for the study of Sacred Scripture, and his devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Fr. Casey served as Superior General of his Congregation from 1997 to 2009. He has worked extensively with Saint Joseph Communications since 1995, and has appeared on the Eternal Word Television Network since 1999.
