





Fr. Casey attributes his call to the priesthood to the Divine Mercy, his love for the study of Sacred Scripture, and his devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

Fr. Casey served as Superior General of his Congregation from 1997 to 2009. He has worked extensively with Saint Joseph Communications since 1995, and has appeared on the Eternal Word Television Network since 1999.

St. Joseph's Catholic Church Lenten Almsgiving Project

St. Joseph's is sponsoring a Lenten Almsgiving Project. Our work of mercy is for children in our community who are in need, by working with **New Foundations Home**. This facility provides emergency shelter as well as short and long-term housing and foster care for 55 children, with ages from 10 to 18, 80% of the residents are boys.

These children are under the custody of the Department of Social Services or the Department of Juvenile Justice. Most were removed from their homes due to neglect or abuse or unsafe living conditions. Sometimes their parents may have been arrested or sent to prison leaving the children nowhere else to go. Some are even dropped off at the facility by the police in the middle of the night, often arriving with nothing but the clothing on their backs. Length of stay at the facility ranges from one week to seven or eight years. Some of these children are placed in foster homes, but others stay until they turn 18.

The children attend public school district 5 and live, eat, sleep, play and do their homework at the New Foundations campus. **They have an ongoing need for hygiene items** such as toothpaste, toothbrushes, body wash, shampoo and deodorant. They are also in need of basic clothing such as socks and underwear.

We are collecting assorted items (see list) throughout Lent, ending on Easter Sunday. The list of items needed is located in the Narthex. Boxes will be placed in the Narthex to drop off your items. Please donate only the items listed as the facility was very specific as to their needs.

Please join our parish in this work of mercy for the love of our Lord this Lenten season and to help these children in need. The goal is to collect enough items to support each child for an entire year. Thank you in advance for your generous support.




