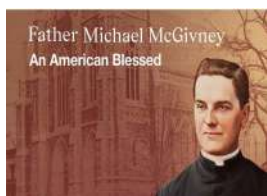

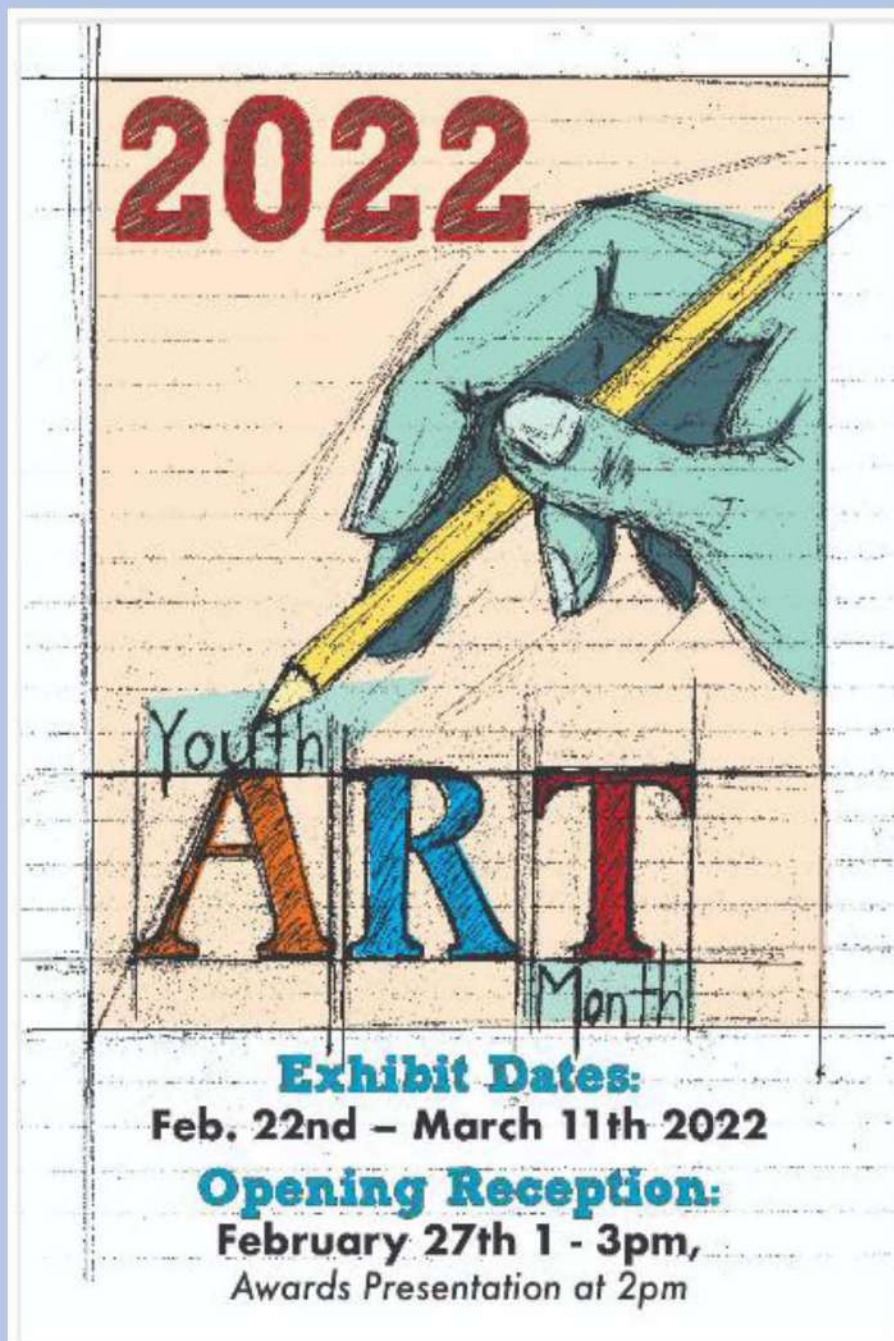

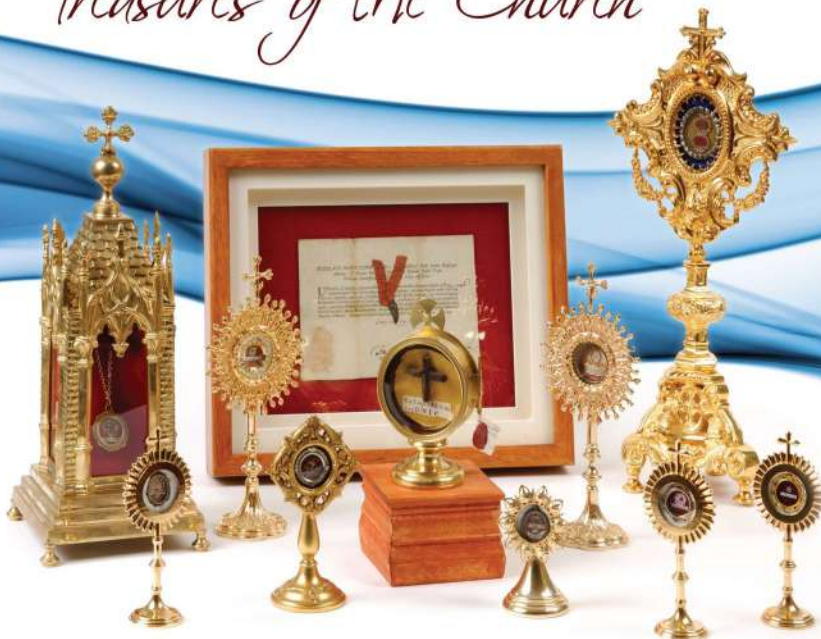
EXPOSITION OF SACRED RELICS

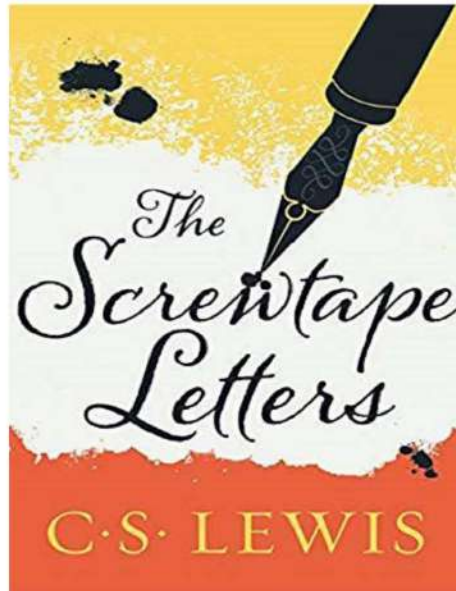

The other is to believe, and to feel an excessive and unhealthy interest in them.” So begins the classic book by C. S. Lewis, *The Screwtape Letters*. The book is written to provide the reader with a clearer understanding of the spiritual dynamic that is present in the world and learn the tactics of the demons. Not surprisingly, this is still one of Lewis’ most popular works.

The book is written from the perspective of an older, more experienced demon, Screwtape, to a younger demon, or “tempter,” Wormwood, who is learning the art of tempting humans. In thirty-one letters, Screwtape provides Wormwood with sage advice and tips on the art of temptation.

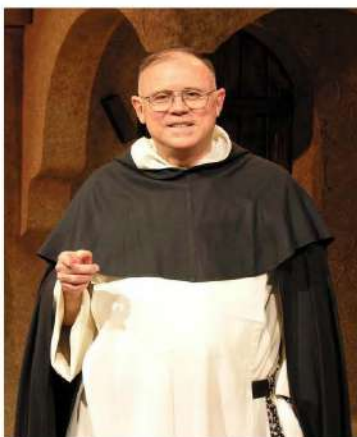
