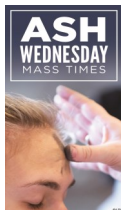

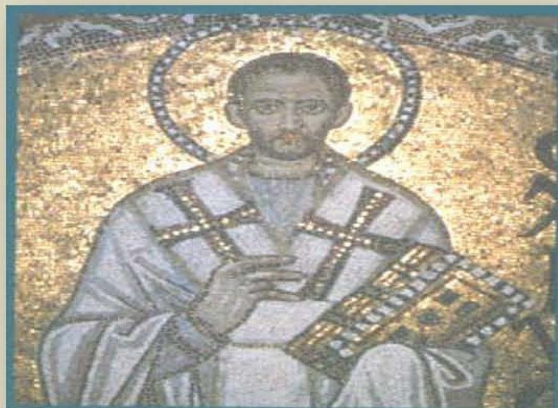

No Confessions and No Eucharistic Adoration on Ash Wednesday

This Pastor's Corner presents the third article in a series of some writings of the early Church Fathers shared from *Staycatholic.com*



ORIGEN AD 185-254

On Purgatory

"If a man departs this life with lighter faults, he is condemned to fire which burns away the lighter materials, and prepares the soul for the kingdom of God, where nothing defiled may enter. For if on the foundation of Christ you have built not only gold and silver and precious stones but also wood and hay and stubble, what do you expect when the soul shall be separated from the body? Would you enter into heaven with your wood and hay

and stubble and thus defile the kingdom of God; or on account of these hindrances would you remain without and receive no reward for your gold and silver and precious stones? Neither is this just. It remains then that you be committed to the fire which will burn the light materials; for our God to those who can comprehend heavenly things is called a cleansing fire. But this fire consumes not the creature, but what the creature has himself built, wood, and hay and stubble. It is manifest that the fire destroys the wood of our transgressions and then returns to us the reward of our great works. (*Patres Groeci*. XIII, col. 445, 448 [A.D. 185-232]).

On baptizing infants

"For this reason, moreover, the Church received from the apostles the tradition of baptizing infants too." Homily on Romans, V:9

Intercession of saints:

"But not the high priest [Christ] alone prays for those who pray sincerely, but also the angels... as also the souls of the saints who have already fallen asleep (*On Prayer II*)

Rosary will start 45 minutes before Mass All are invited to join us praying for the protection of the child in the womb.

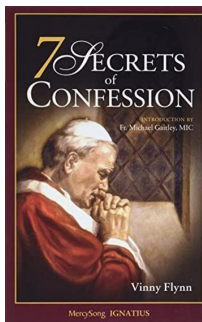

Update from the Knights of Columbus
A Note from the Ukrainian Refugee Family

We have always lived in Ukraine, there we built a house, cultivated a garden, planted vegetables and various trees, and did not intend to go anywhere, but unfortunately, we were also forced to become refugees in your country due to the fact that on February 24, 2022, a brutal war began in our country. In fact, it is very scary when you hear a siren, scream, or see a plane flying and dropping bombs on ordinary houses where peaceful people live: families, small children, grandparents. Children do not go to school, you constantly have to run when hearing a siren and hiding in bomb shelters is very difficult. Our family left Ukraine when our youngest son was 2 weeks old, we have 7 children in all, we had to leave the country because we were worried about the children, their stress, and their health, because it's all on a psychological level, for their future I don't want anyone to experience this in my life. First of all, you have been a support all this time, and I thank God very much that God sent all of you who helped us, for these funds, which we very gratefully sent, may God reward you a hundredfold!!!

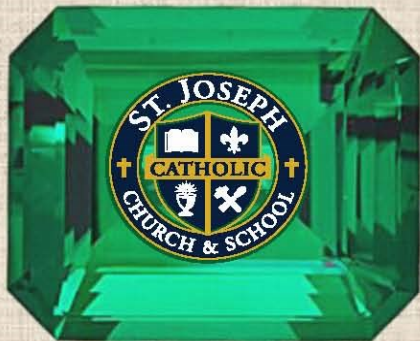

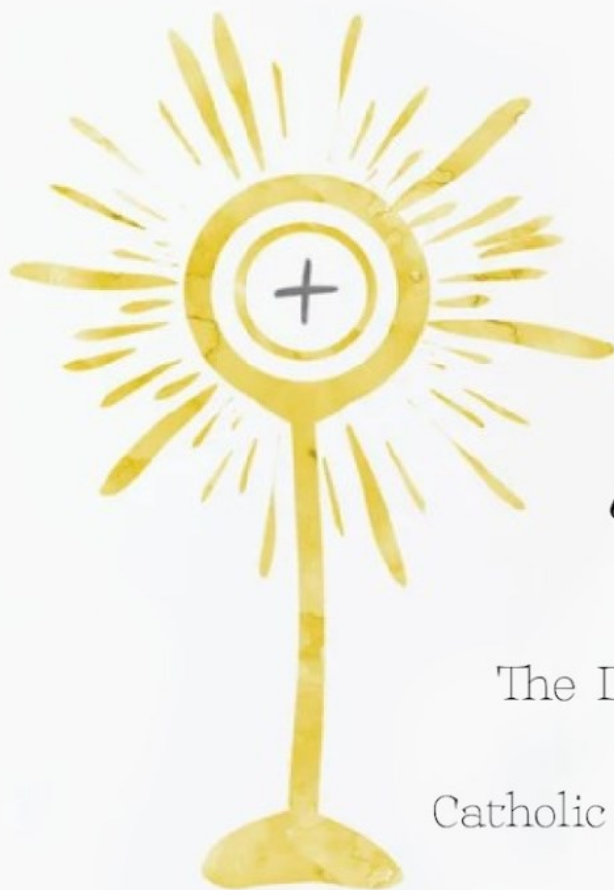

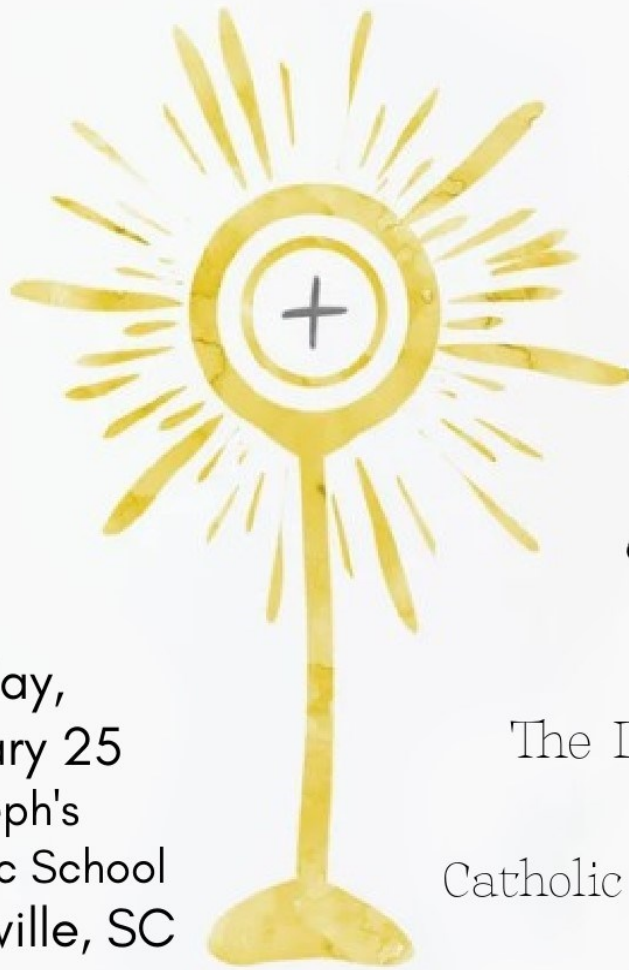
