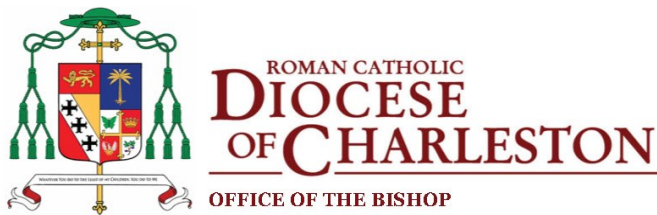
Join Family Honor and Fr. Philip S. Gillespie on a Pilgrimage to Greece

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As your bishop, it is my responsibility to oversee the formation of the men who have answered God's call to enter the seminary. This includes funding their education, housing, and training needs for 6-10 years of formation. On Sunday, June 11, we will take up our Annual Seminary Collection to help in the support of the 17 men who are studying to be priests for our diocese. This collection, along with the Catholic Appeal of South Carolina (formerly the BAA) are the primary sources of revenue for the seminarians. By supporting their formation process, you are helping them to prepare spiritually, morally, and pastorally to shepherd in Christ's name.

In addition to your financial support, I urge you to pray for more young men to respond to God's call to the priesthood as our needs continue to increase with the growing Catholic population of our state. Keeping in mind Jesus' own words that "the harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few" (Lk 10:2), I ask all our people in the diocese to offer encouragement to young men to consider the priesthood and for young women to consider the call to religious life.

Some details about Seminarians in the Diocese of Charleston:

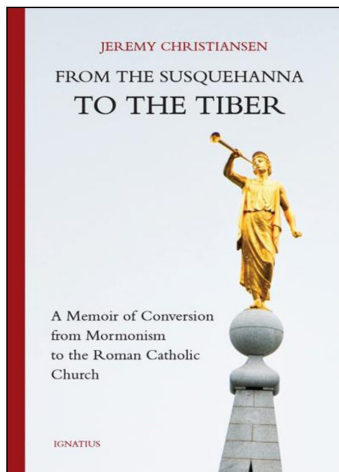
- The diocese currently has 20 seminarians for the 2023-24 academic year.
- Of the 20, 5 are college seminarians, 3 are pre-theologians, and 12 are theologians.
- Formation takes 6-10 years depending on the person.
- We currently have seminarians in PA, FL, and Washington, DC.
- We ordained one priest this year and 2 transitional deacons.
- The average cost per seminarian per year is about \$46k.
- Revenue Sources - Catholic Appeal of South Carolina and this second collection.

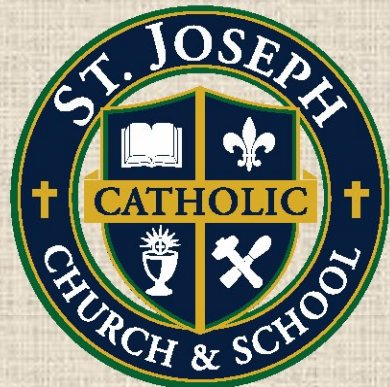
