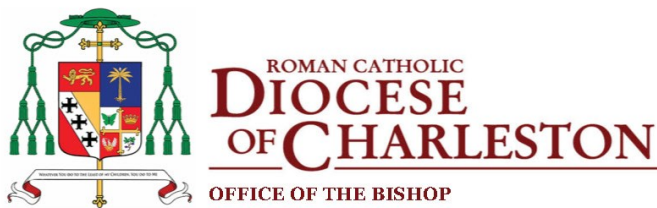

## PASTOR'S CORNER: LETTER FROM OUR BISHOP



June 18, 2023

My dear brothers in Christ,

I thank you for dedicating your lives to care for, protect and provide for your families. I would like to take this opportunity to encourage you and to assure you of my continued prayers for you.

You have been blessed with the gift of fatherhood and have inherited a high calling: to imitate our Father in heaven. Especially in our time, the importance of fatherhood is downplayed or assumed to be unnecessary. But we learned through and from Jesus that a father has the vital responsibility of guiding his children in right paths — God chose Joseph to be Jesus' father.

We read in the book of Proverbs, "Train the young in the way they should go; even when old, they will not swerve from it" (22:6). 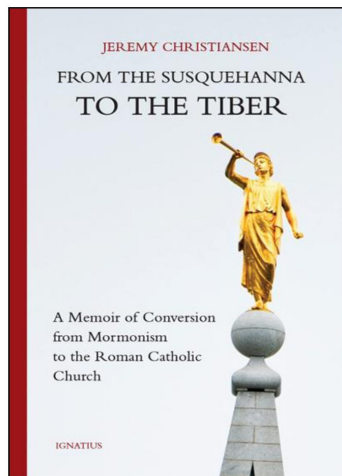

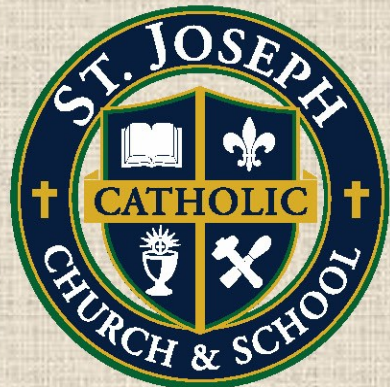
