



My dear brothers in Christ,

I thank you for dedicating your lives to care for, protect and provide for your families. I would like to take this opportunity to encourage you and to assure you of my continued prayers for you.

You have been blessed with the gift of fatherhood and have inherited a high calling: to imitate our Father in heaven. Especially in our time, the importance of fatherhood is downplayed or assumed to be unnecessary. CLERGY APPRECIATION DINNER






