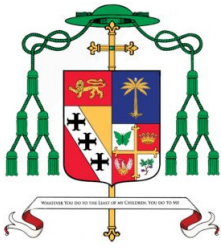

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

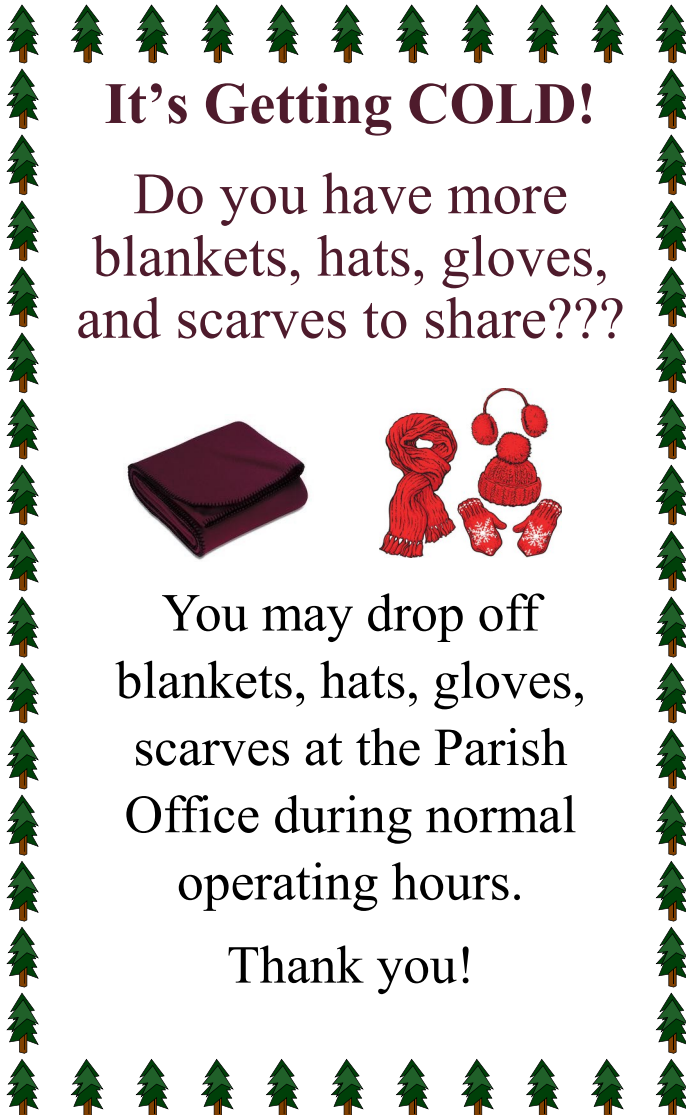

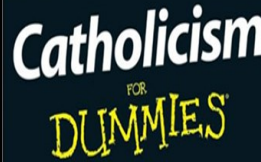

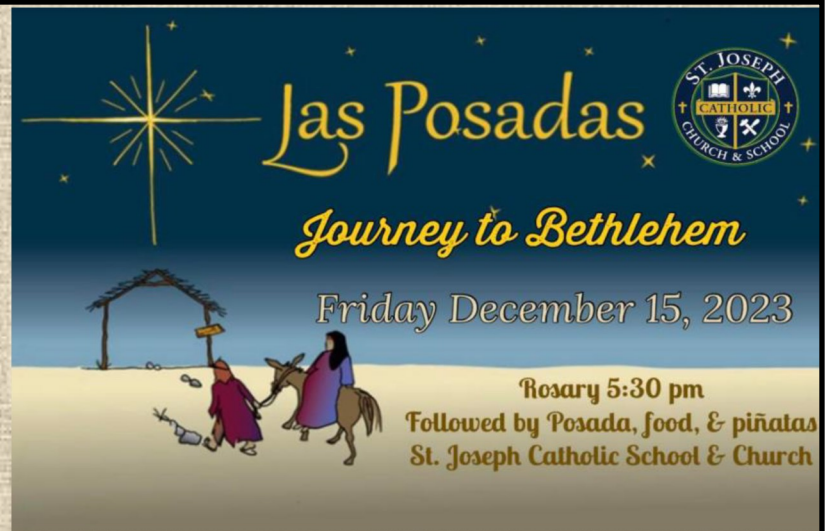
