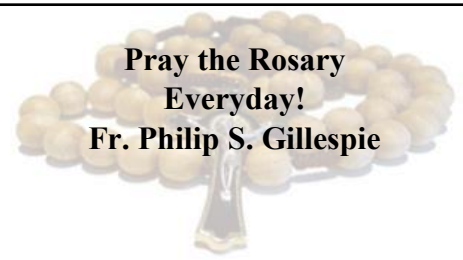

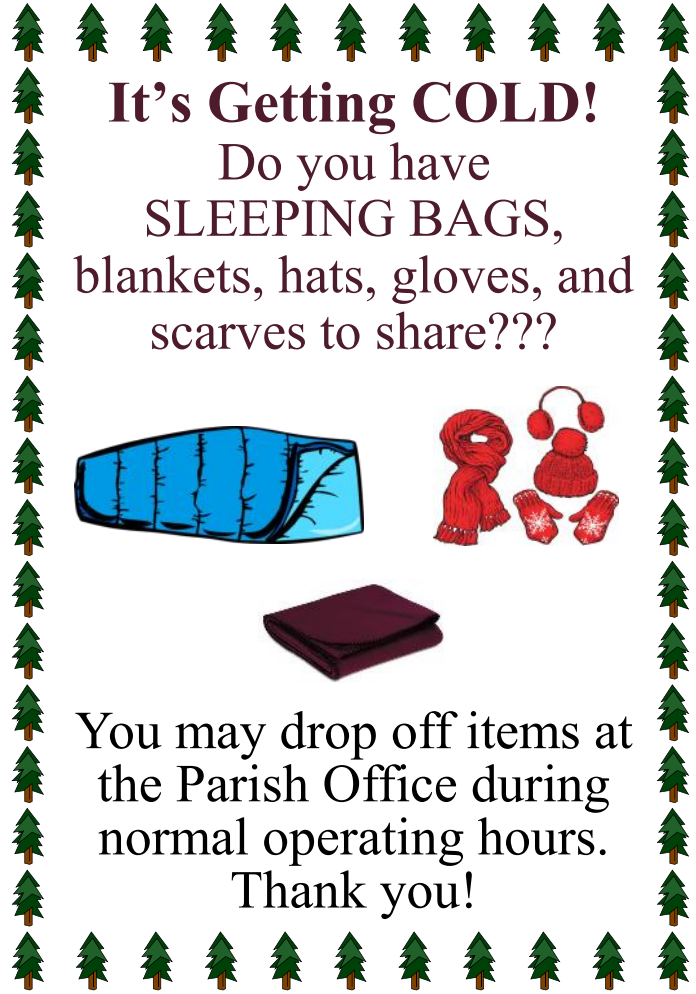
WHAT IS THE EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUND (ESFT)?
