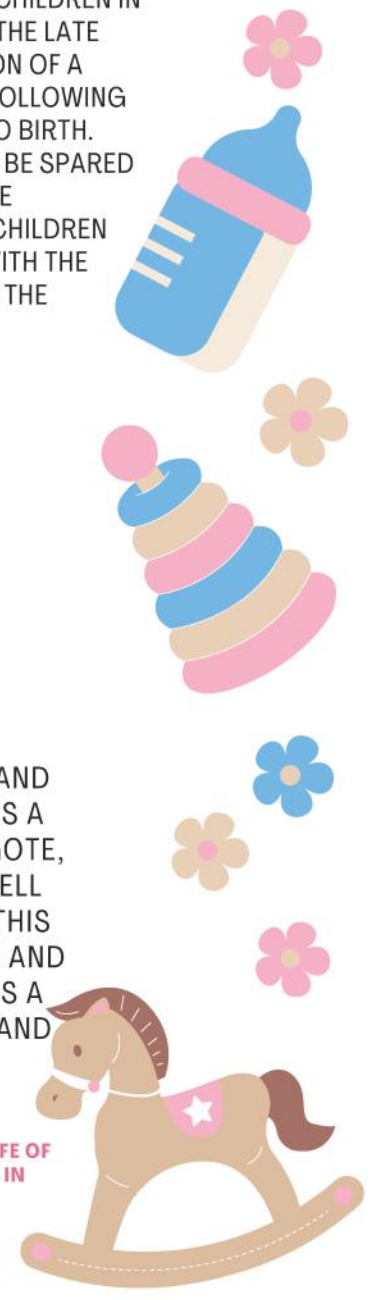


**DAY 1: CONCEPTION**

AT THE MOMENT OF CONCEPTION, A NEW LIFE IS FORMED, AND A UNIQUE HUMAN PERSON IS CREATED. THIS NEW PERSON IS A SOUL WITH A BODY MADE OF A SINGLE CELL, CALLED A ZYGOTE, WHICH IS NOT THE MOTHER OR THE FATHER. THIS SINGLE CELL CONTAINS ALL OF THE BIOLOGICAL MATERIAL THAT GIVES THIS NEW HUMAN LIFE ITS OWN INDIVIDUAL TRAITS SUCH AS EYE AND HAIR COLOR, HEIGHT AND APTITUDE. ALL THAT IS NEEDED IS A SAFE AND NOURISHING HOME TO BE ABLE TO LIVE, GROW, AND DEVELOP.
