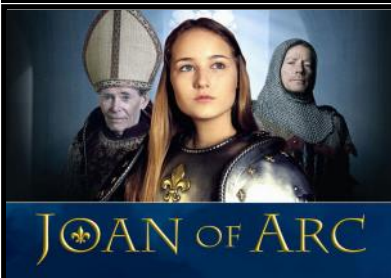

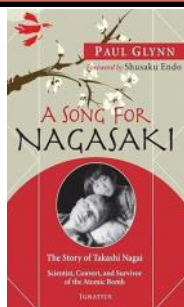

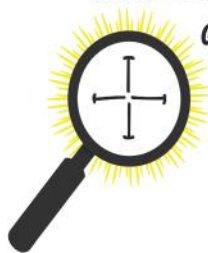

EMBRYO AT 4 WEEKS



**“The Spirit of God has made me, and the breath of the Almighty gives me life.”
Job 33:4**

At four weeks, the baby is called an embryo and has two layers of cells called the epiblast and the hypoblast. These cells are developing into all of the baby’s body parts and systems. The embryo is about 2mm long, about the size of a poppy seed. It’s protected by an amniotic sac, which is filled with cushioning fluid, and attached to a tiny yolk sac that provides all the nourishment it needs. The outer layer will later develop into the placenta and provide your baby with oxygen and nutrients.
