

At 12 weeks, the last week of the first trimester, the baby is around 5.4cm about the size of a plum. They can open and close their hands (making a fist) and curl their toes. The internal organs and muscles have grown, and the skeleton made of tissue is hardening into bone. The vocal chords are formed this week, the baby is able to swallow and the kidneys are now functioning.
