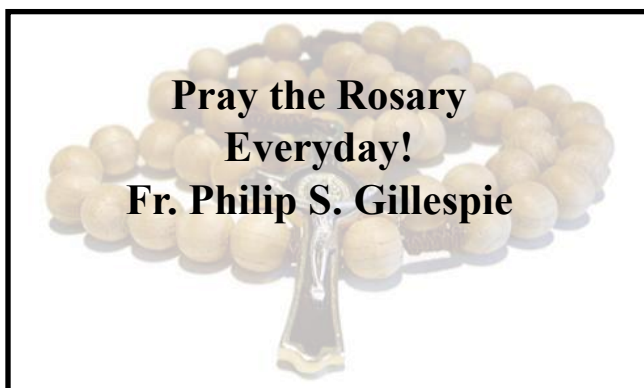
## **End-of-Life Workshop**
