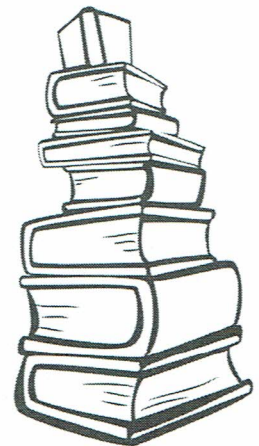


# Summer Reading Assignment

## Don't know what to read? Here are some suggestions!

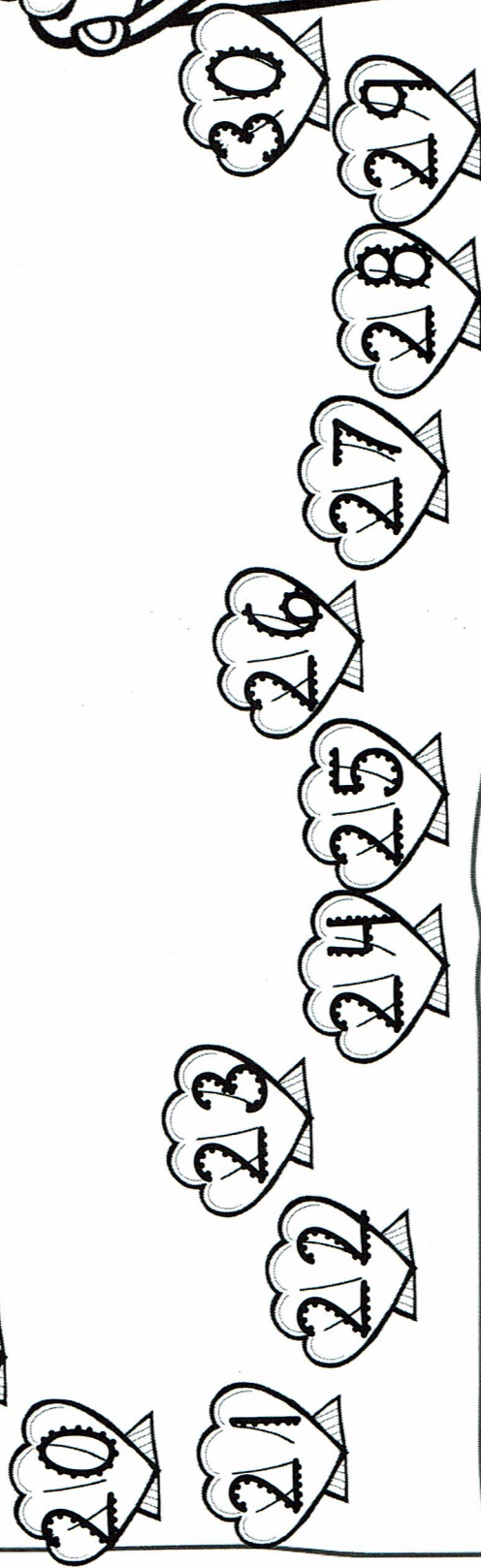
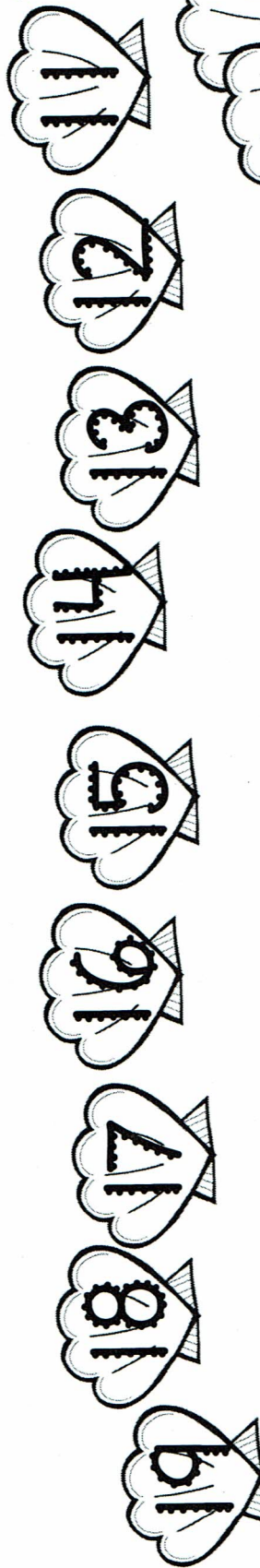
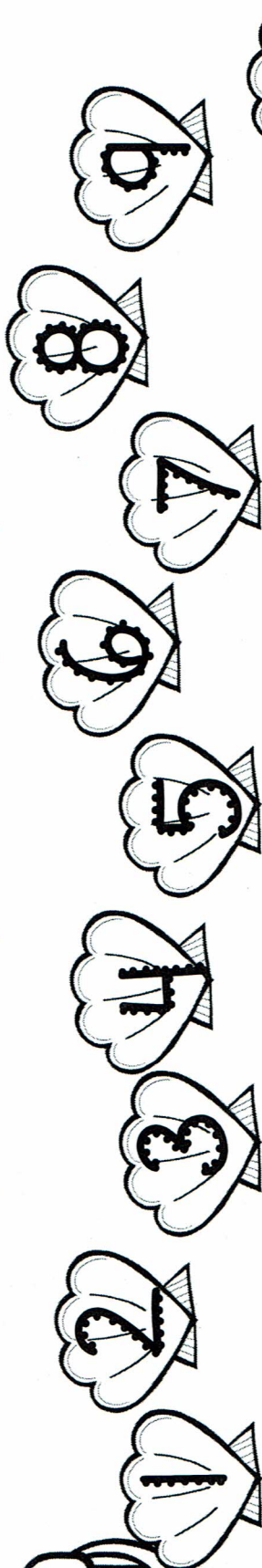
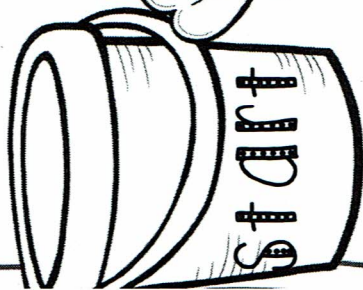
- Laura Numeroff books (*If you Give a Mouse a Cookie, If you Give a Moose a Muffin*, etc)

Color in a shell for every 20 minutes you read per day. Can you build a sand castle?

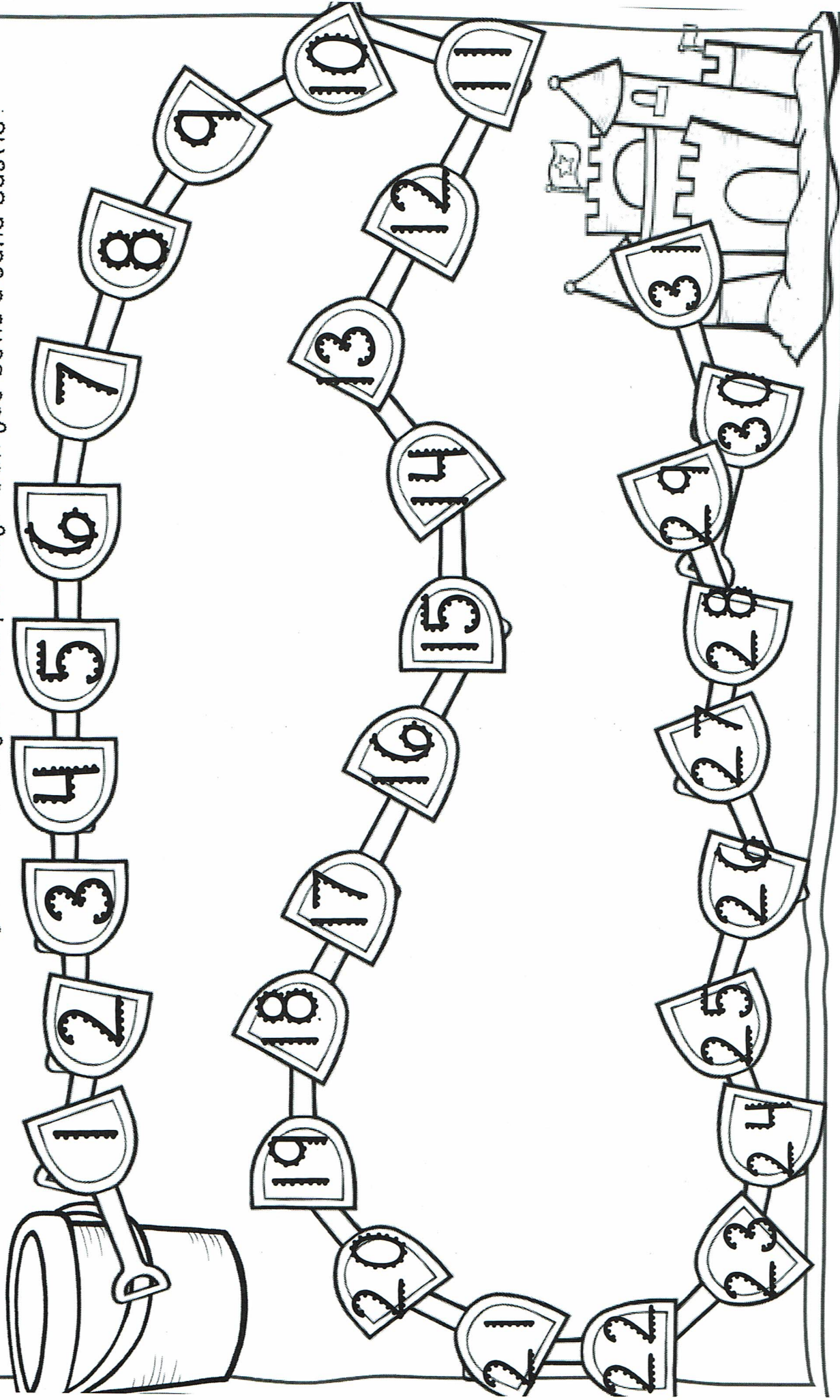

Color in a shovel for every 20 minutes you read per day. Can you build a sand castle?

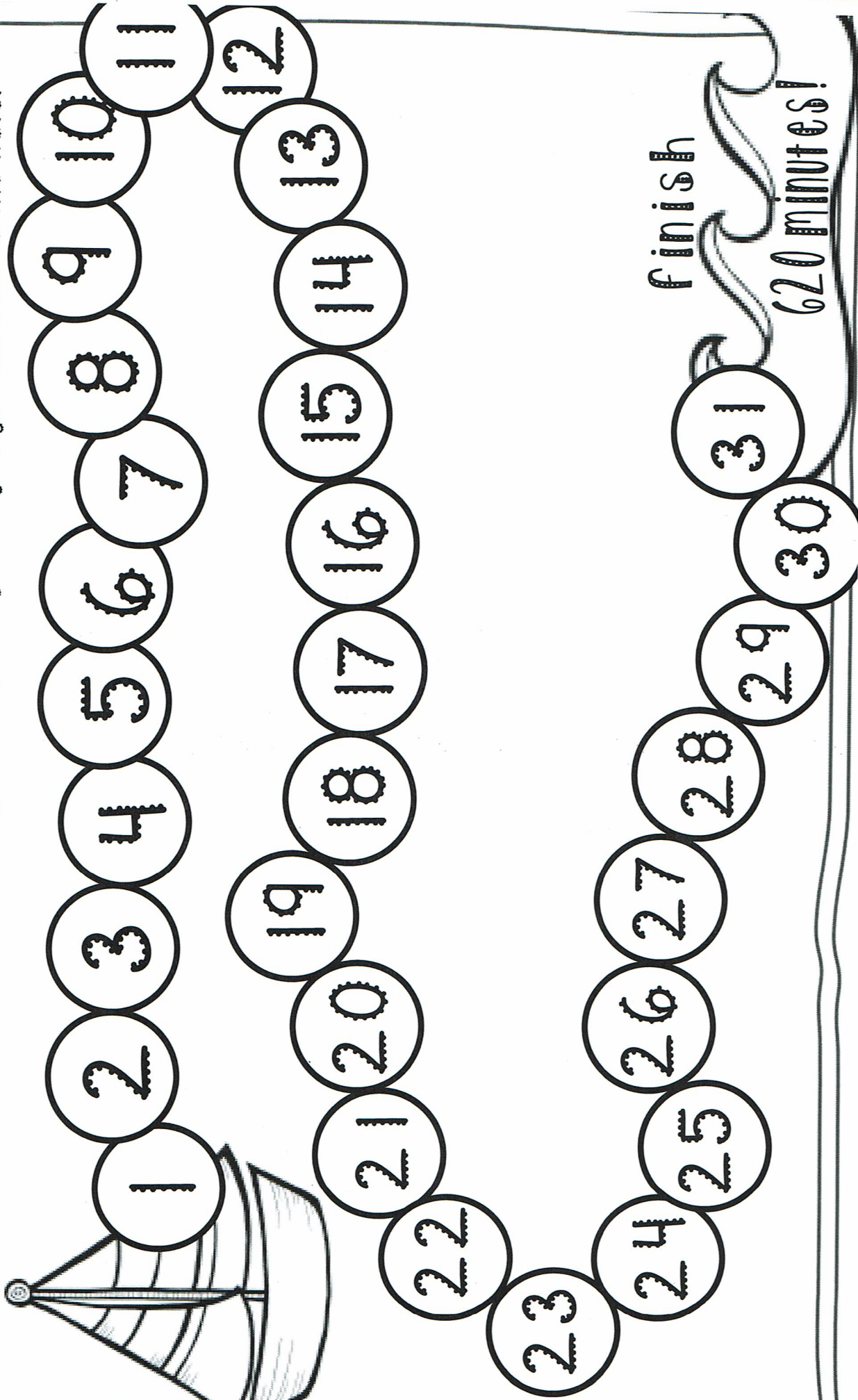
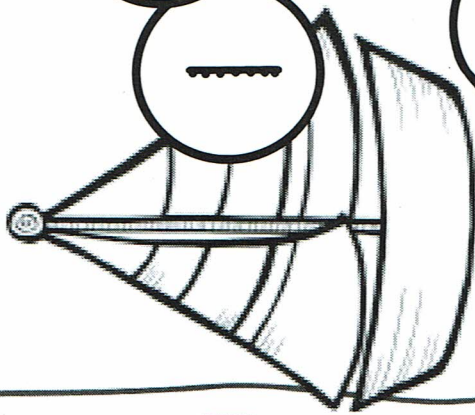




# On My Way to 1st Grade!
