Reading:

Students will complete a reading log for the months of June and July. They should read at least 20 minutes a day. Students will complete the attached book review on a book of their choice. The book review will be due on the first day of school for a project grade in ELA. Any work not turned in on the first day will receive points off in accordance with the school's late work policy.

Math:

Students need to be proficient in multiplication facts for 4th grade. We begin our year with place-value and multi-digit addition/subtraction, but the majority of our year is heavily focused on multiplication. If they do not come into 4th grade knowing their multiplication facts, math will get increasingly difficult for them. You should practice daily at home with flash cards to retain and develop fluency. There is also opportunity for practice online with IXL or www.mathdrills.com.

Religion:

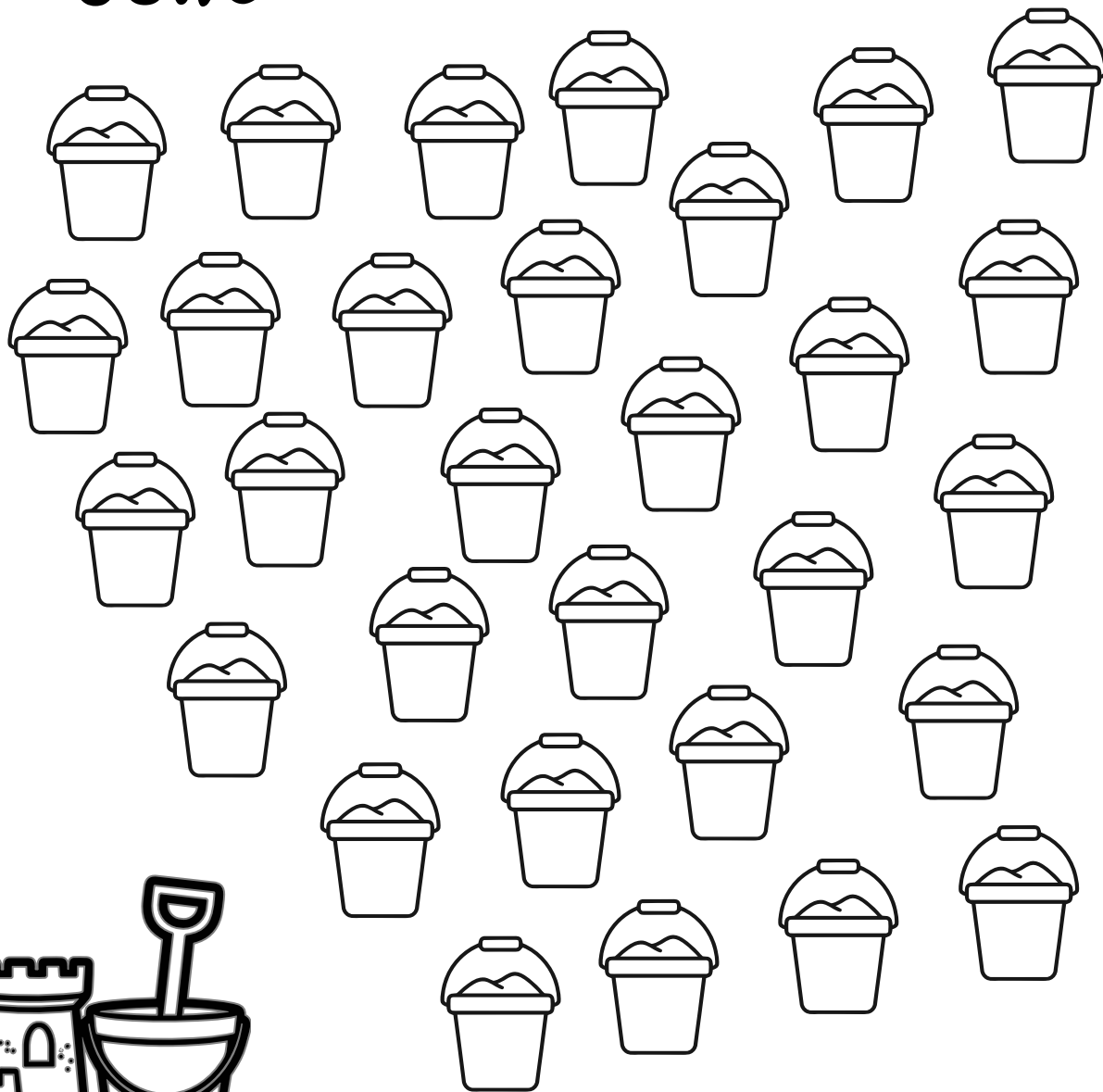

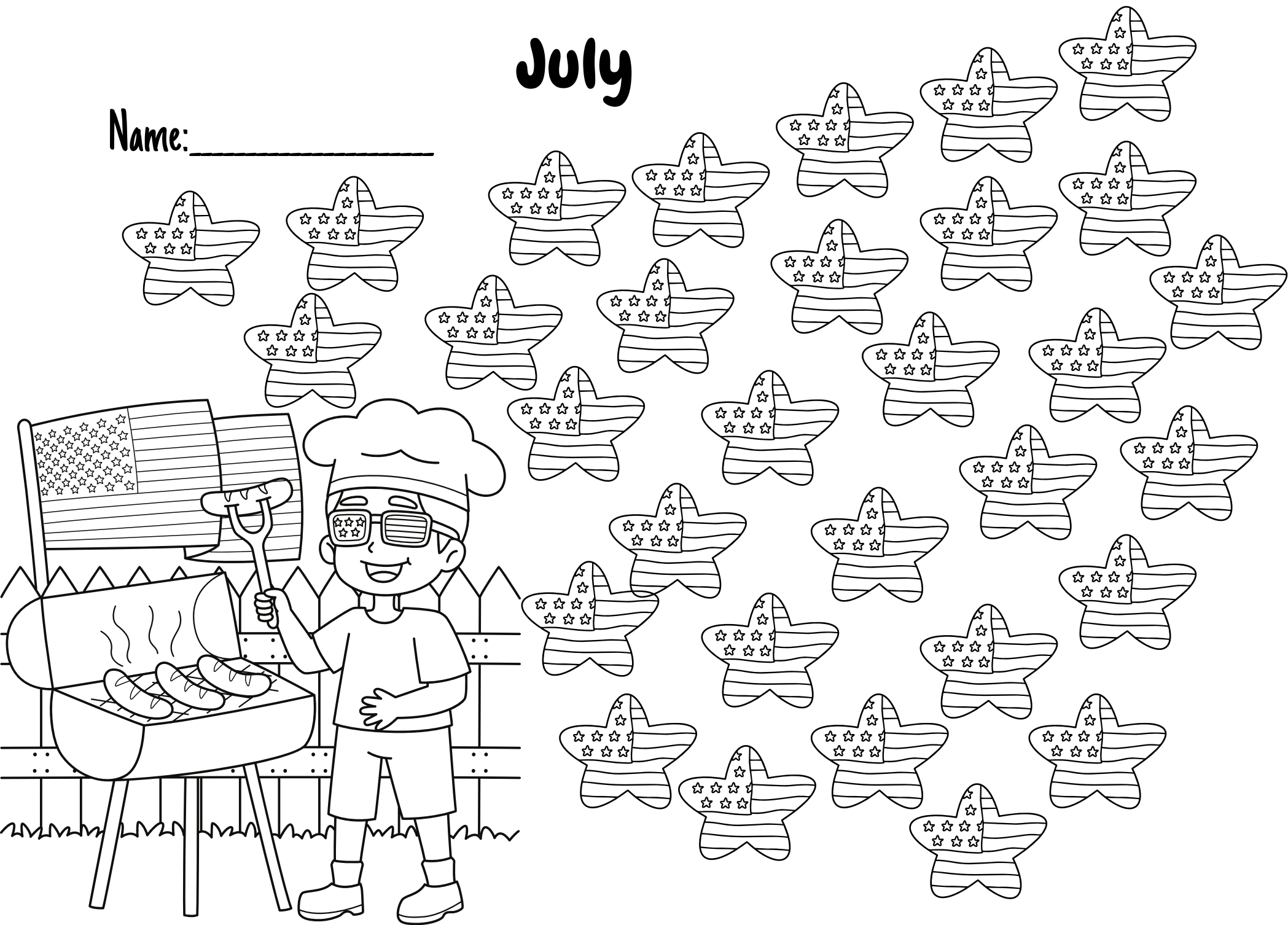

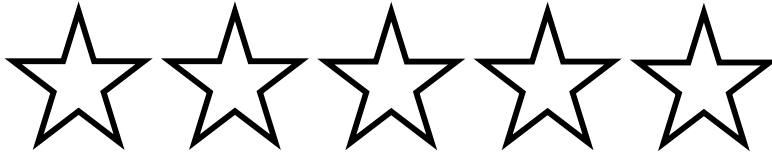
